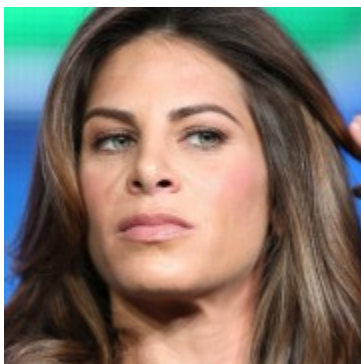
Tara Lipinski and Johnny Weir are in Sochi as NBC Olympics figure skating analysts, and they are *bringing it* with their commentary.

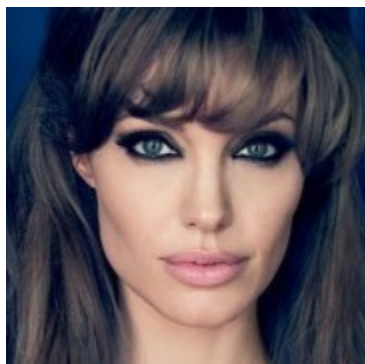
