Dog lost eye, he got 10 days

DUPAGE | Man ordered to pay \$1,500 for injuring terrier

Toni Fedor let her boyfriend baby-sit her dog, Sophie, while she worked then was horrified to find her beloved pet had been beaten so severely the pup lost an eye.

Her now ex-boyfriend was sentenced Monday to 10 days in jail for injuring the Jack Russell terrier and ordered to pay nearly \$1,500 in restitution to cover veterinary bills.

The jail time imposed on Randall Madison, 26, of Carol Stream is justified given the harm he caused, Fedor said.

"I feel like it's a punishment that fits the crime," said Fedor, 24.

Madison was convicted of misdemeanor animal cruelty for injuring Sophie on Dec. 29, 2007. During his trial, Madison insisted Sophie was injured when he accidentally fell on the pet while roughhousing with her.

DuPage County Judge Jane Mitton also placed Madison on probation for two years, ordered him to undergo a psychological evaluation and sentenced him to perform 150 hours community service work.

Fedor said Sophie has recovered from her injuries.

"She's doing great," Fedor said. "She bounced back and she's her normal, happy self."
